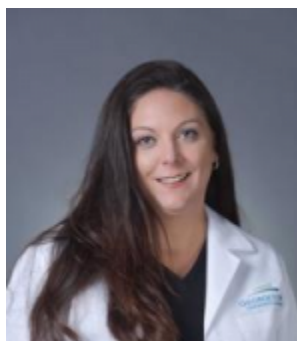

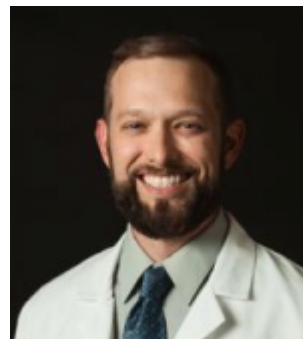

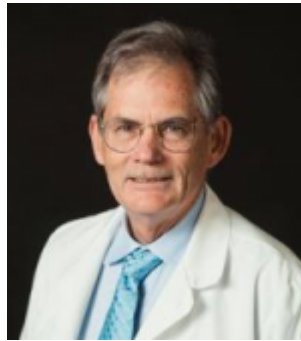

Imaging

Quality Imaging Services That Are Accessible

Modern medicine depends on radiology and imaging services for establishing informed treatment plans. As a medical provider, you need resources that support your practice. Our facility provides **accurate, dependable and convenient imaging resources** for you and your patients.

Reliable Radiology Services

Radiology testing uses radiant energy to take pictures and visualize many body parts. Our radiologists use these tests to determine a diagnosis and evaluate treatment. Here are some of the tools and tests we use to help establish care plans for your patients.

Mammography

Mammography is an X-ray used to detect and diagnose breast concerns. With **equipment dedicated to these breast exams**, we provide high-quality, low-dose radiation to evaluate breast problems, such as a lump, pain or nipple drainage.

Nuclear imaging

Nuclear imaging is **one of the least invasive and most detailed scans** for diagnosing and monitoring various treatments. This safe and effective testing utilizes a radioactive tracer for clear visualization. A medical professional typically administers the tracer intravenously.

Your patients may be concerned about the terminology “nuclear” or “radioactive,” but patients need to understand that this test is safe, effective and has no side effects. Additionally, the amount of radiation administered is minimal. Common conditions that can benefit from nuclear imaging are the following:

- Blood disorder
- Thyroid disease
- Heart disease
- Gallbladder disease

- Lung problems
- Bone issues
- Kidney disease
- Cancer

After the tracer collects in the tissue, a radiation detector produces digital signals, which are stored on a computer and can be generated to film. Our facility is committed to establishing a safe environment, and *our radiologists are available to answer any questions.*

CT scan

Computerized tomography, or CT scan, is a series of X-ray images that take pictures from different angles around the body. The cross-sectional images help our skilled radiologists visualize blood vessels, bones and other tissue. This **efficient and convenient test allows for quick examination**, especially when the patient is at risk of internal injury or trauma. CT scans help diagnose diseases and plan medical, surgical and radiation therapies.

MRI

Magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) uses magnets and radio waves, processed by computers, to generate images. This noninvasive test utilizes a large, tube-shaped magnet to create cross-sectional images of organs, tissue and the skeletal system. Our knowledgeable radiologists often use this **imaging tool for diseases that CT scans don't detect.**

Ultrasound

An ultrasound, or sonography, produces high-intensity sound waves to visualize structures within the body. This safe and effective test **does not use any radiation.**

We often think of ultrasound during prenatal care. Besides monitoring the uterus, ovaries, and embryos during pregnancy, this test can be used for many other reasons.

- Diagnose gallbladder disease
- Evaluate blood flow
- Guide needles for biopsy or treatment
- Visualize breast lump
- Examine thyroid gland
- Check genital or prostate problems

- Assess joint inflammation
- Determine bone disease

Our well-trained and personable sonographers understand how to manipulate this technology and can put your patients at ease.

X-ray

Our medical staff uses X-rays, or radiographs, for a wide range of injuries, diseases and disorders. Your patients can receive radiographs with or without contrast. Though this test uses a small amount of radiation, it is considered **safe for all ages, including babies**. However, pregnant women should avoid X-rays as they can harm the growing embryo.

Trabecular Bone Score (TBS)

Advancing the Standard of Bone Health

Worldwide, there is one osteoporosis fracture every three seconds. More than 50% of major osteoporotic fractures occur in non-osteoporotic patients. While bone mineral density (BMD) alone is a key factor in assessing fracture risk, it does not identify all individuals who are at high risk of fracture.

What is TBS iNsight™?

TBS iNsight™ is a state-of-the-art software that evaluates bone micro-architecture in patients during a standard DXA scan. This technology is integrated with your patient's DXA scan and provides a full picture of your patient's risk of fracture.

What are the benefits of TBS?

- Identify more patients at risk of fracture by combining TBS with BMD
- Fine-tune therapy decisions and monitor changes in primary and secondary osteoporosis
- Improve patient management

Certain antidepressants and anticonvulsants are proven to reduce chronic and neuropathic pain. Additionally, we have observed incredible results from using NSAIDs and the ERAS protocol. That’s why we take a holistic approach to pharmaceutical pain management and use opioids when necessary.

Interventional pain management

Interventional pain management targets the pain at its source. It uses image-guided techniques and minimally invasive procedures. We are proud to offer the following interventional pain management approaches:

- **Targeted injections:** Precise medication delivery can reduce inflammation and prevent pain signaling.
- **Nerve blocks:** These medications numb and inhibit pain signals from a compressed nerve.
- **Radiofrequency ablation:** This technique utilizes heat energy to disable the nerve's pain signals.
- **Pain pumps:** These implanted devices deliver medication directly into the spinal fluid.
- **Spinal cord stimulation:** These implantable devices use adjustable electrical currents to disrupt pain signaling. Patients alter the electrical currents using a handheld device.

With these innovative strategies, pain specialists boast improved results with fewer side effects.

Chronic pain management

Chronic pain lasts three months or more. Approximately **52 million individuals report chronic pain**. Some common causes include:

- Nerve damage
- Arthritis
- Osteoporosis
- Autoimmune disorders
- Injury
- Headaches
- Cancer

No two patient's pain experience is precisely the same. That's why patients with chronic pain need a personalized plan. For many of these patients, a single approach is not sufficient. They require a more thorough strategy.
